	From California City proper: Take California City Blvd. East until you reach the edge of the golf course. Best Western will be on your right as you approach the light. Turn left and travel 1.3 miles until you reach a fork in the road at the large gazebo. Turn left onto Randsburg-Mojave Rd. Follow this dirt road for about 4 miles until you reach the entrance of the Desert Tortoise Research Natural Area.
